Verulam Golf Club is pleased to welcome all visitors throughout the year. We hope that our format for visiting societies guarantees a pleasant sociable day and a great golfing experience. Being a traditional and historic Member's Golf Club we expect visitors to honour our codes of behaviour, including our dress code. We ask that society organisers ensure their group members are all aware of these rules to avoid any embarrassment. Visitors not conforming to our Club rules will be asked to leave the Clubhouse or the Course.

Conditions of Play

- ◆ All guests must have a current Club handicap certificate or a society handicap certificate. It is important that all guests observe all usual golfing etiquette on the course and keep up with the match in front not just ahead of the one behind.
- ◆ Gentlemen must play from the yellow markers and Ladies from the red markers. To meet your timetable for the day and to speed up play, we ask you to play Stableford (rather than Medal or Texas Scramble) as a 3-ball or Greensome Foursomes, both in the morning and afternoon.
- ◆ Could you please ask your members to:
Repair pitch marks, Replace divots, Rake bunkers (and leave rakes in them), Play briskly (3 ¾ hours for a 3-ball)
- ◆ Only wide-wheeled trolleys are allowed on the Course. Please note, trolleys, both manual and powered may be hired from the Professional. Telephone 01727 861401.
- ◆ Please check if there is a trolley ban before booking with the course information line on **01727 864902** or ring the professional shop on **01727 861401**. Visitors should note that from 3 October 2011 there will be some minor disruptions to the course due to the installation of a new irrigation system.
- ◆ Note that golf clubs may not be brought into the Clubhouse. We strongly recommend that these are locked away in a car when not in use.
- ◆ If there is a possible threat of thunderstorms or local lightning strikes on the day of your visit, you are advised to exercise extreme caution and ensure you follow the Club's safety guidance notes. In the event of a thunderstorm, you are advised to abandon your golf equipment and return to the Clubhouse or stay in the open in a crouched position.

Clubhouse

- ✚ You will have free access to all the Club's facilities including the Member's Locker Room and showers (towels are provided), spike bar, lounge and patio.
- ✚ Please note that the Clubhouse opens at 7.00am and closes at 10.30pm
- ✚ We ask visitors to dress appropriately whilst playing and socialising. On the course, this means wearing proper golf shoes and golf trousers or tailored/golf shorts, not below knee length, with knee-length socks or sports socks which are visible above their footwear. In the clubhouse, you are not allowed to wear denim, t-shirts or trainers and to change for dinner, especially if clothing is muddy or wet. Please advise your members of our dress code. We do reserve the right to ask your visitors to leave the course or clubhouse if they fail to comply but it is obviously embarrassing for us to do so.
- ✚ All fire exits are clearly visible if the fire alarm rings, everybody must leave the Clubhouse immediately and assemble at the Fire Assembly points located by the flagpole at the front of the Clubhouse or in the car park at the rear of the Clubhouse. Any fire alarm tests will be notified on your arrival.
- ✚ Mobile phones may not be used on the course or in the Clubhouse lounge or dining areas. They may be used in the Stud Bar, which is a designated Business Centre. Wi-Fi is available in the Clubhouse. Please ask the bar staff for the password.
- ✚ There is a security door entry system on the entrance doors to the clubhouse and the locker rooms. The access number for the day may be obtained from the Professional's shop.
- ✚ **WARNING** Verulam cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to cars or other property and accepts no responsibility for valuables left in the Clubhouse or its surrounds. You are reminded that trophies, prizes or other property left in the Clubhouse or elsewhere are the owner's responsibility.

Location

Verulam Golf Club is situated on London Road (A1081), 0.8 miles south-east of St Albans City centre.

When travelling from the major routes below the golf club entrance is 1.4 miles along London Road from the London Colney roundabout - go straight through 1 roundabout and 2 traffic lights, then turn left immediately after the iron railway bridge.

When using Satellite Navigation Systems & Route Planners:

Input - 226 London Road, St Albans, AL1 1JG or postcode AL1 1JG

Directions

From M1 junction 7 : Take the M10/A414 towards St Albans. At the Park Street roundabout take the 2nd exit (A414) towards Hatfield. At the London Colney roundabout take the 1st exit London Road (A1081) to St Albans.

From M25 eastbound junction 21A: Take the A405 towards St Albans. Continue on the A405 through 2 roundabouts. At the Park Street roundabout take the 3rd exit (A414) towards Hatfield. At the London Colney roundabout take the 1st exit London Road (A1081) to St Albans.

From M25 westbound junction 22: Take the London Colney Bypass (A1081) towards St Albans. At the London Colney roundabout take the 3rd exit London Road (A1081) to St Albans.

From A1(M) junction 3: Take the A414 towards St Albans. Continue on the A414 at the Colney Heath roundabout. At the London Colney roundabout take the 4th exit London Road (A1081) to St Albans.
